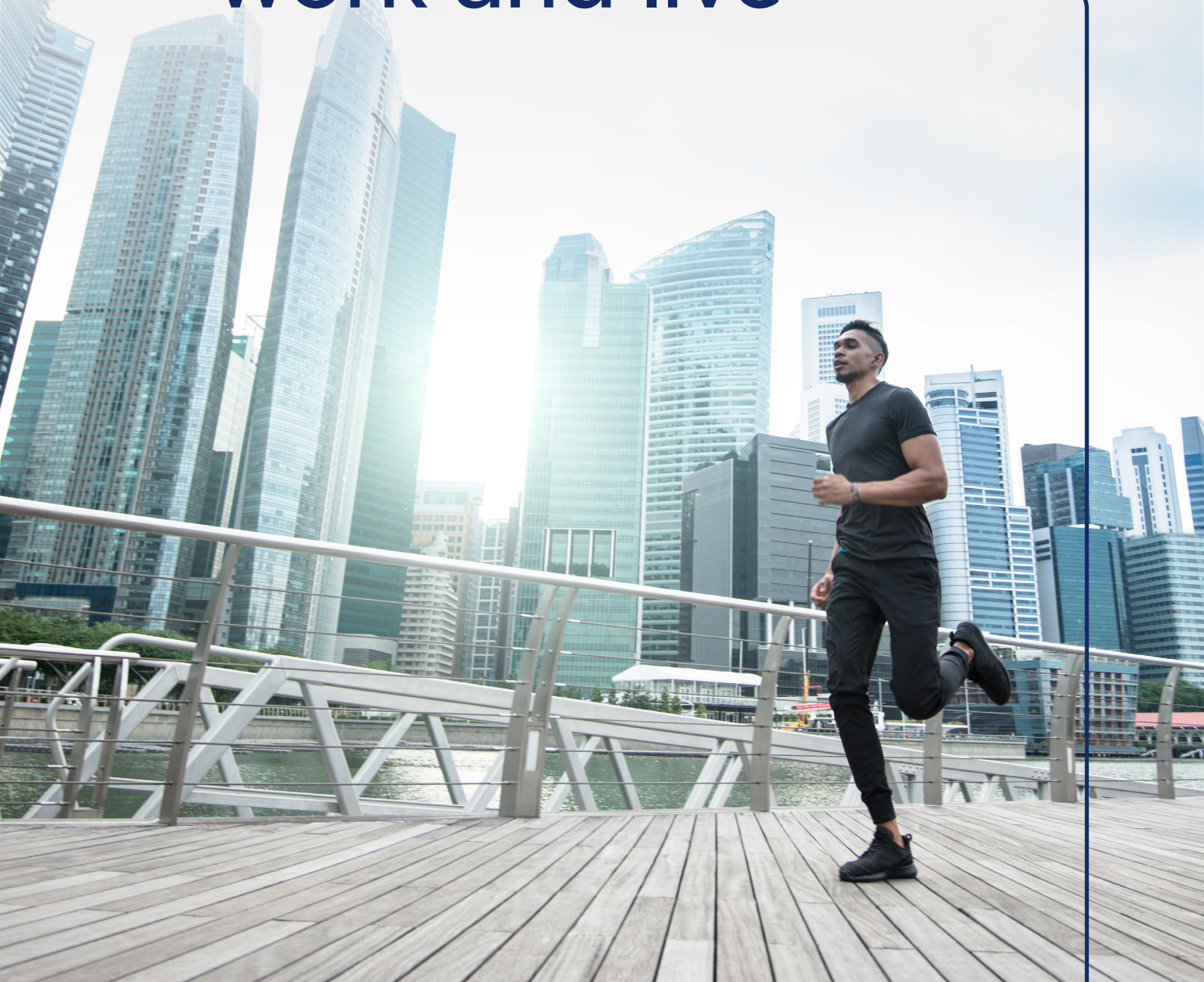

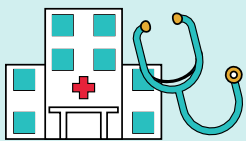


Curious about life in Singapore? Here's what you need to know.

Singapore, Asia's economic powerhouse, has long been home to global multinational corporations, growing startups, and the top talent who drive and power their operations here.

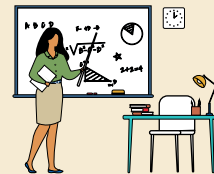

Guarantee a quality education for the kids

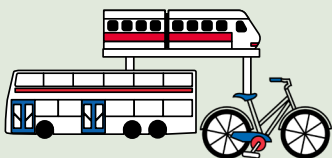
Singapore ranks 1st in the world in school quality and for science and mathematics education. Lessons are taught in English at all of Singapore's mainstream schools.

Apart from local institutions, there are also more than 30 international schools offering various curricula and programmes.

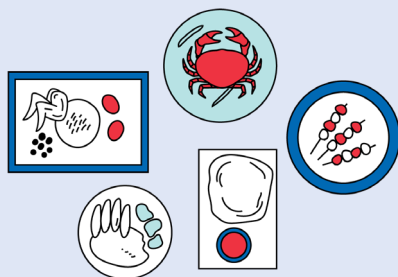


Move seamlessly with our connected transport network

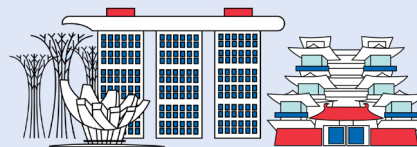

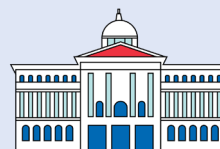
Live life to the fullest in a cultural metropolis

What Singapore's ONE Pass can do for you and your family



Plan for your future in Singapore, with ONE Pass' validity period of 5 years



Enjoy **career flexibility** to start, operate, or work for **multiple companies concurrently across different industries**



Relocate easily, with dependant passes for **family members**. Spouse of pass holders will be able to work upon receiving a Letter of Consent



Ensure **greater stability** as the **personalised pass is tied to the individual** rather than the employer



Wondering if you're eligible for ONE Pass? Apply if you are:



Top talent with outstanding achievements working in the business, arts and culture, sports, science and technology, academia, and research



An **existing pass holder** or **overseas candidate**, who earned a fixed monthly salary of at least S\$30,000 within the last year or will earn it under your future Singapore-based employer



Overseas candidates will also need to demonstrate that you **have been or will be working for an established company in Singapore**
