I will walk to the entrance of Science Centre Singapore.

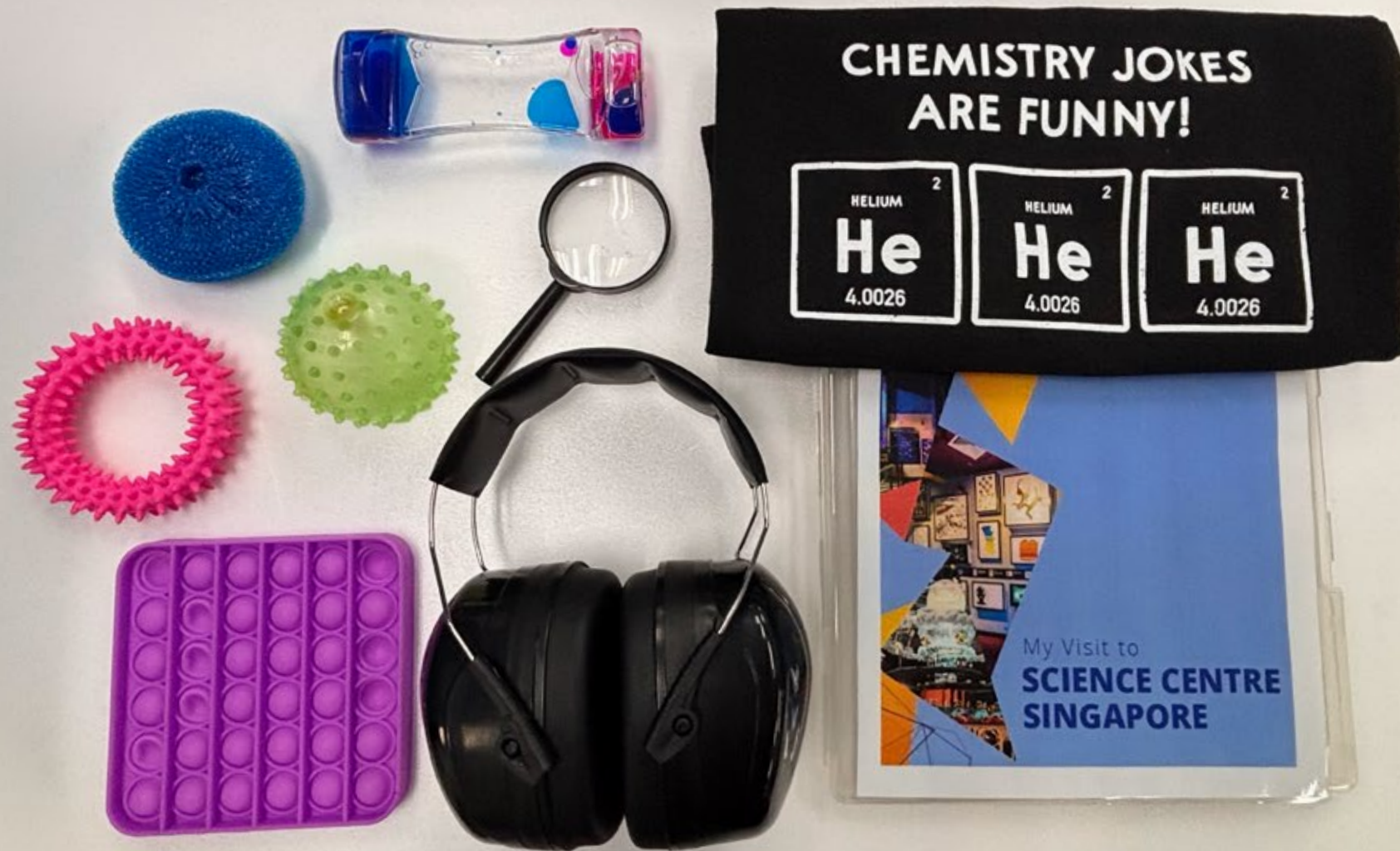


Next, I will go to the ticketing counter to scan my ticket.
