I am visiting KidsSTOP™ today for a Science Play Programme with my teachers and classmates.



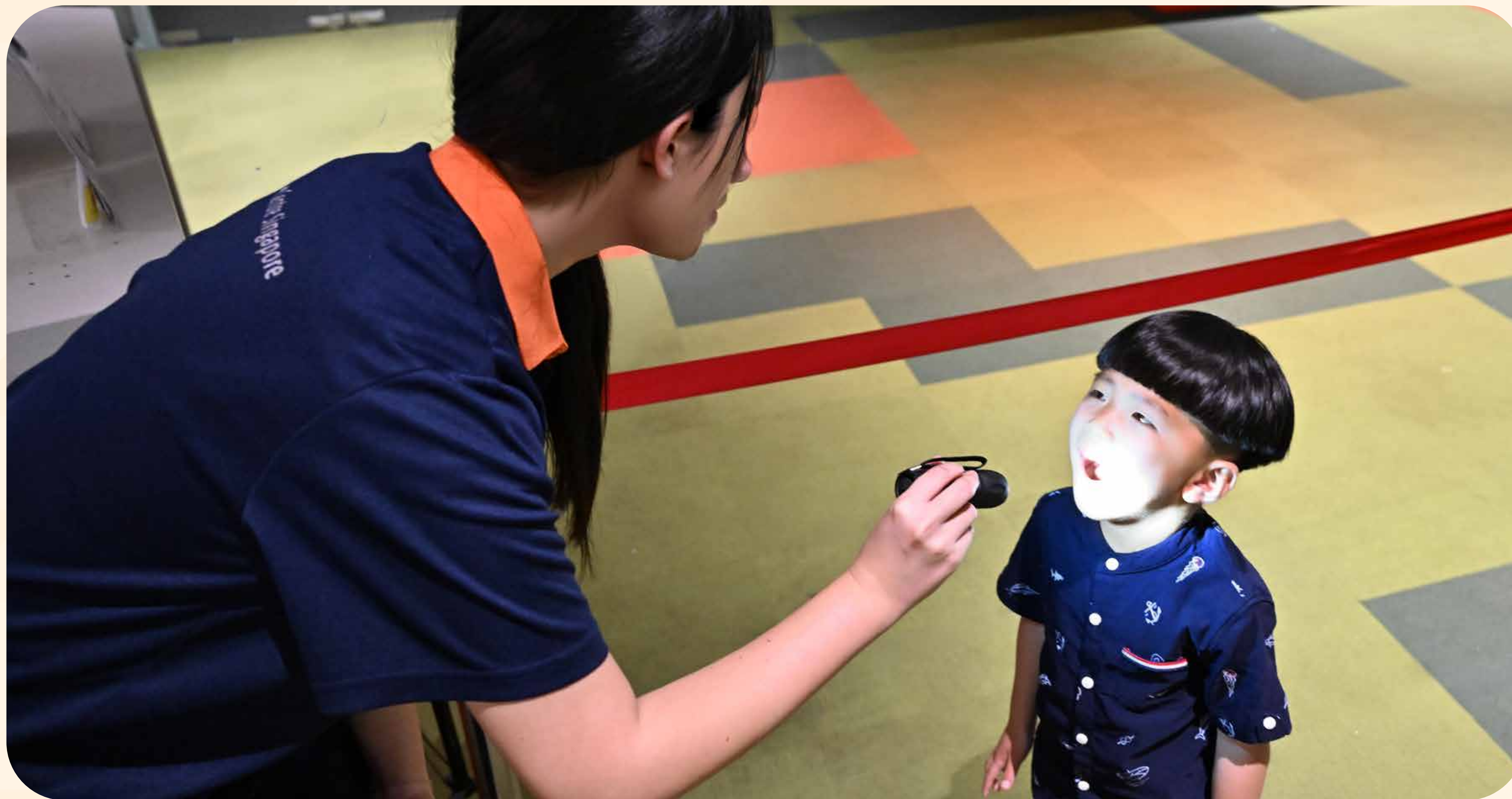
I will be learning science while I play.

The staff will be checking my hands and mouth with a flashlight.

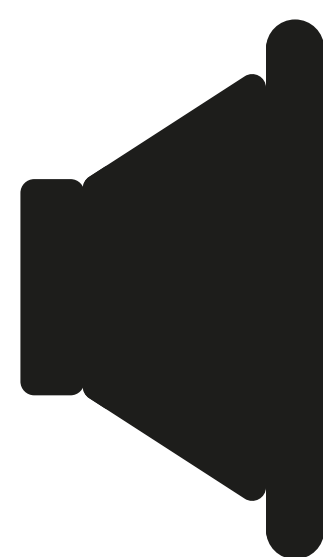


They will also sanitise my hands.

Too Loud

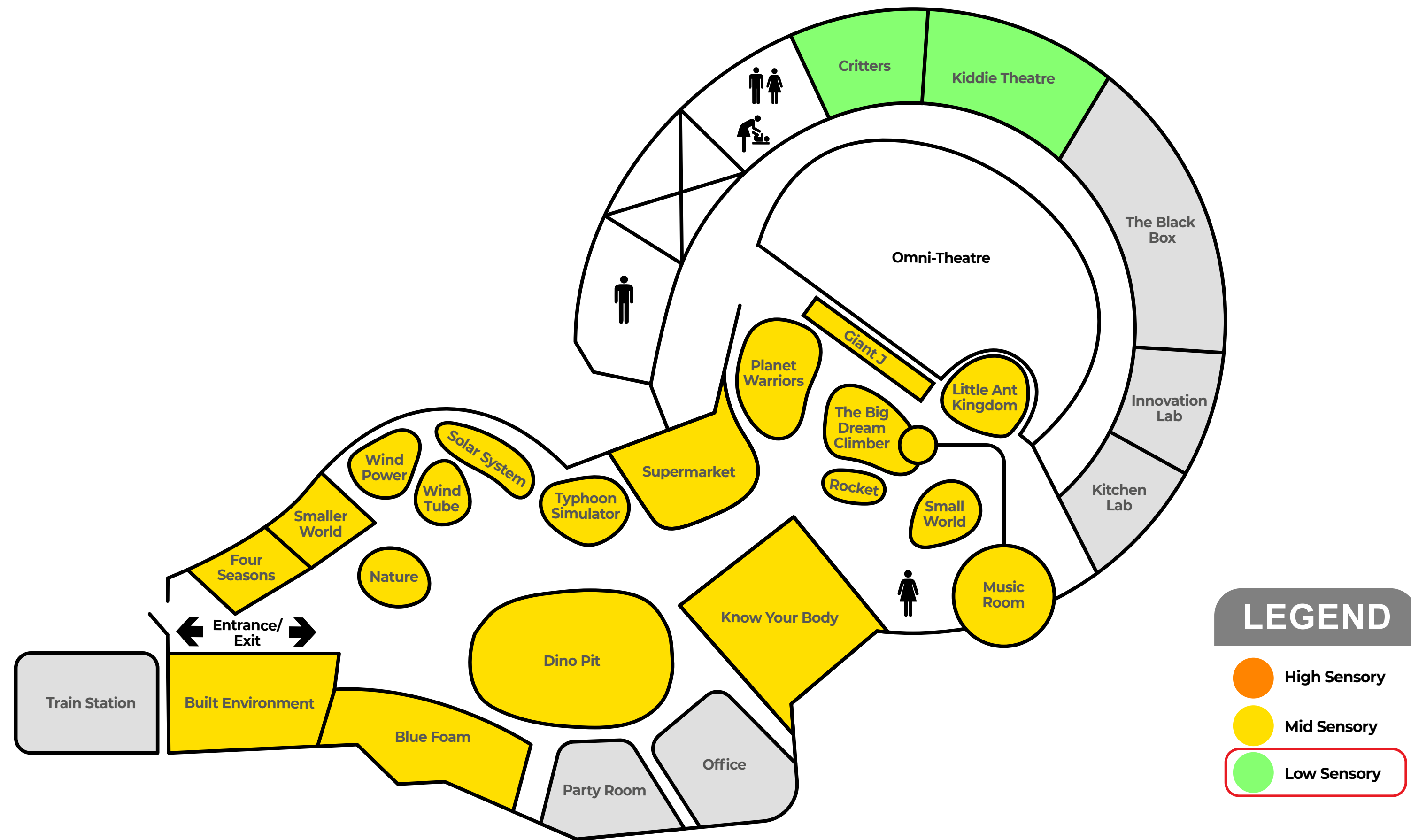


Way too loud
