

Electronic Sanitary & Phytosanitary (eSPS) Certificate Guide

- 1) To access the eSPS enquiry service, importers and their authorised Declaring Agents require a corppass account assigned with digital service "Customs eServices". Details can be found at [Quick Links for Traders | Singapore Customs](#).
- 2) Importers and their authorised declaring agents can retrieve and trace their eSPS via www.customs.gov.sg > eServices > Search for "Electronic Sanitary and Phytosanitary (e-SPS) Enquiry Service" or via the URL go.gov.sg/espsevenquiry.
- 3) To perform the query traders are to select **Inbound Enquiry**.

- 6) After obtaining the certificate details, declaring agents can use the information to declare for a permit in TradeNet. It is crucial that the information is declared accurately according to the eSPS details (eg. certificate reference number, HS and product code, quantity etc). Please note that for declaring the establishment code of imported meat and meat products:
- select the 'processing premises ID' that is tagged to 'type of processing: 39-processing', which is 77 in the 5(d) example
 - key in the country prefix, followed by the **processing premises ID**, i.e. NZ77 based on the 5(d) example, at the **'CA/SC code 1'** field in TradeNet during permit application.
